



A Landscape Assessment Study for the Macedon Ranges

Macedon Ranges Shire Council is currently preparing a Landscape Assessment Study which will:

- Review significant views and vistas in publically accessible locations across the Shire.
- Focus on the visual, cultural and historic qualities of these landscapes.

Our shire is characterised by a broad range of landscapes that are formed by the local topography, patterns of vegetation, waterways, and features of cultural, environmental, geological and scientific significance.

The Study includes all land within the Shire, excluding land within settlements.



Study process

From now until Monday 12 March 2018, the project team will be identifying community values.

We will be seeking input from community members and groups, and will be asking for feedback on which landscapes or views are most important and why.

The project team will then carry out an assessment of landscape significance and prepare implementation recommendations for the management of landscape character and significance through the planning scheme. During this stage we will consult with the community on the significant landscapes that have been identified.

This will be followed by a planning scheme amendment process, which will include formal exhibition of the amendment and an opportunity to comment on any proposed changes to the planning scheme.
